



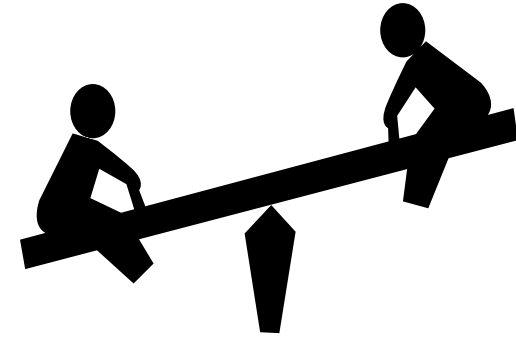

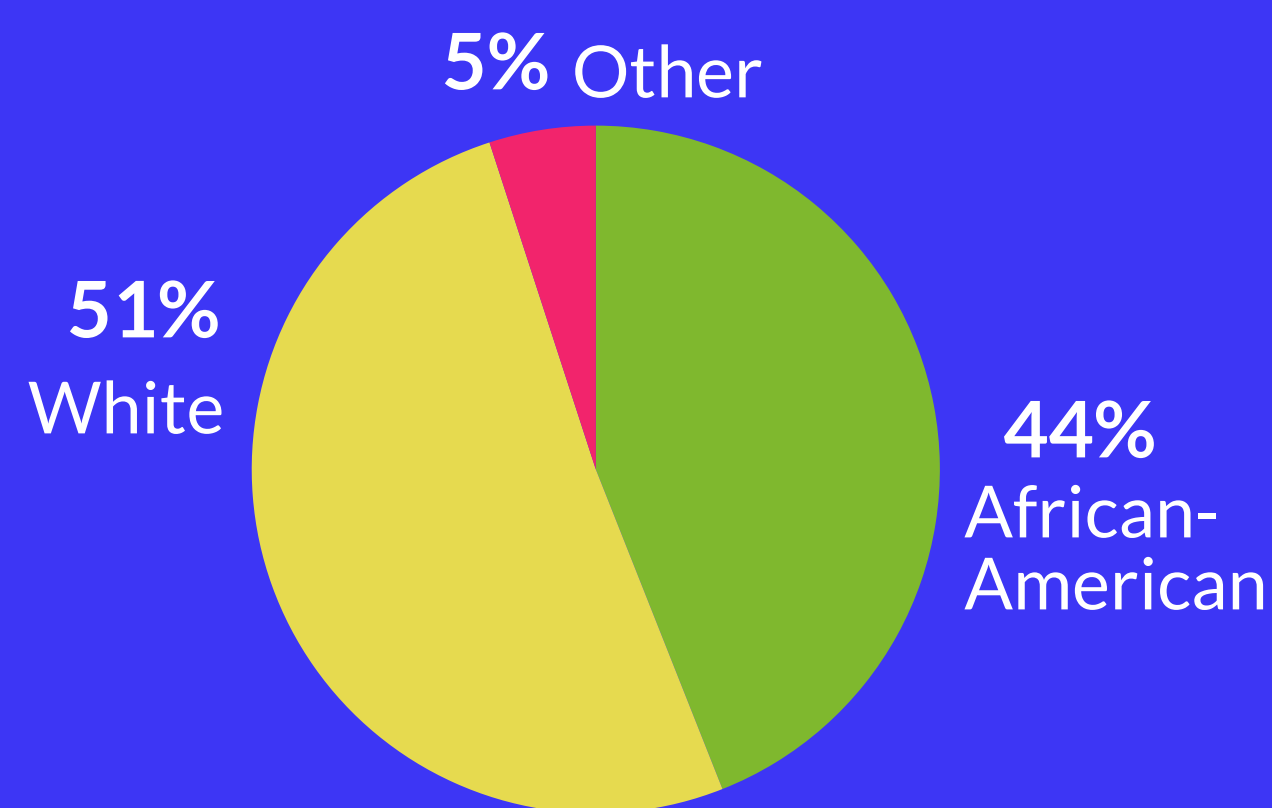

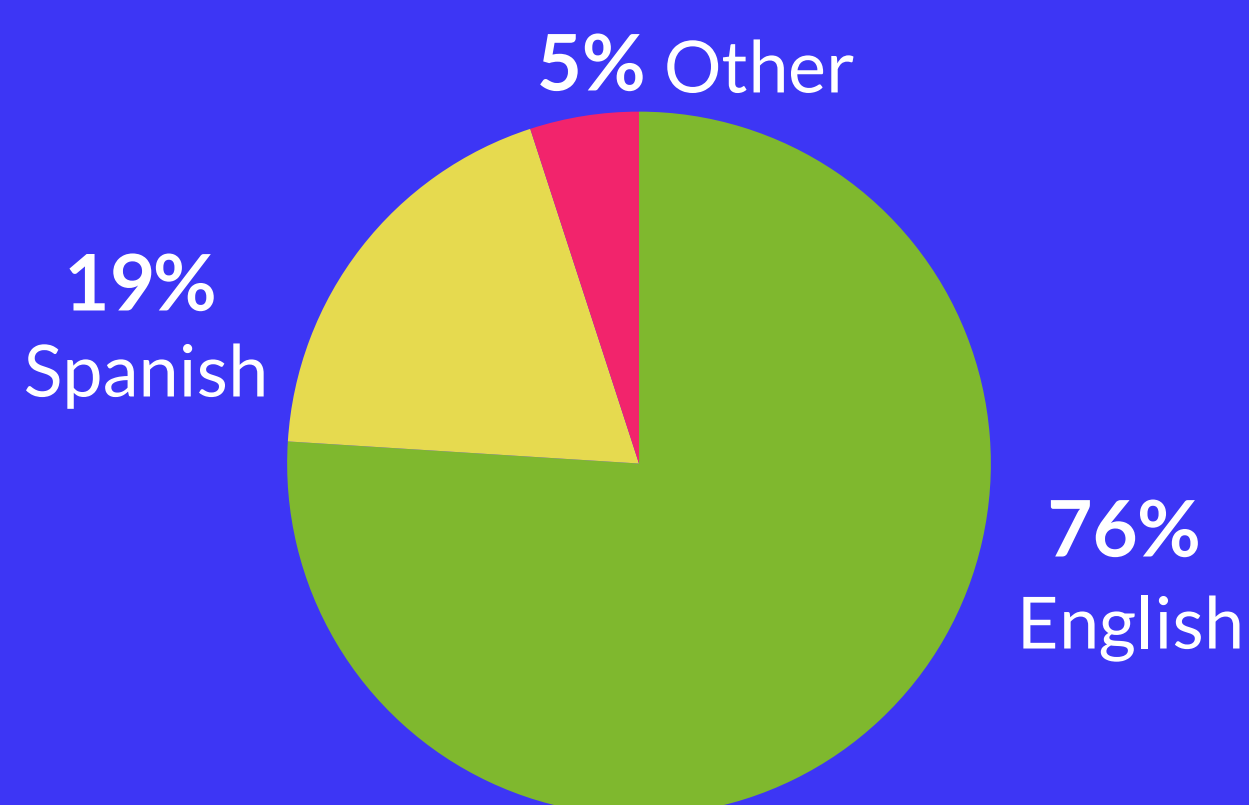
MIECHV Serves High-Need Families

- 5% Experiencing Homelessness

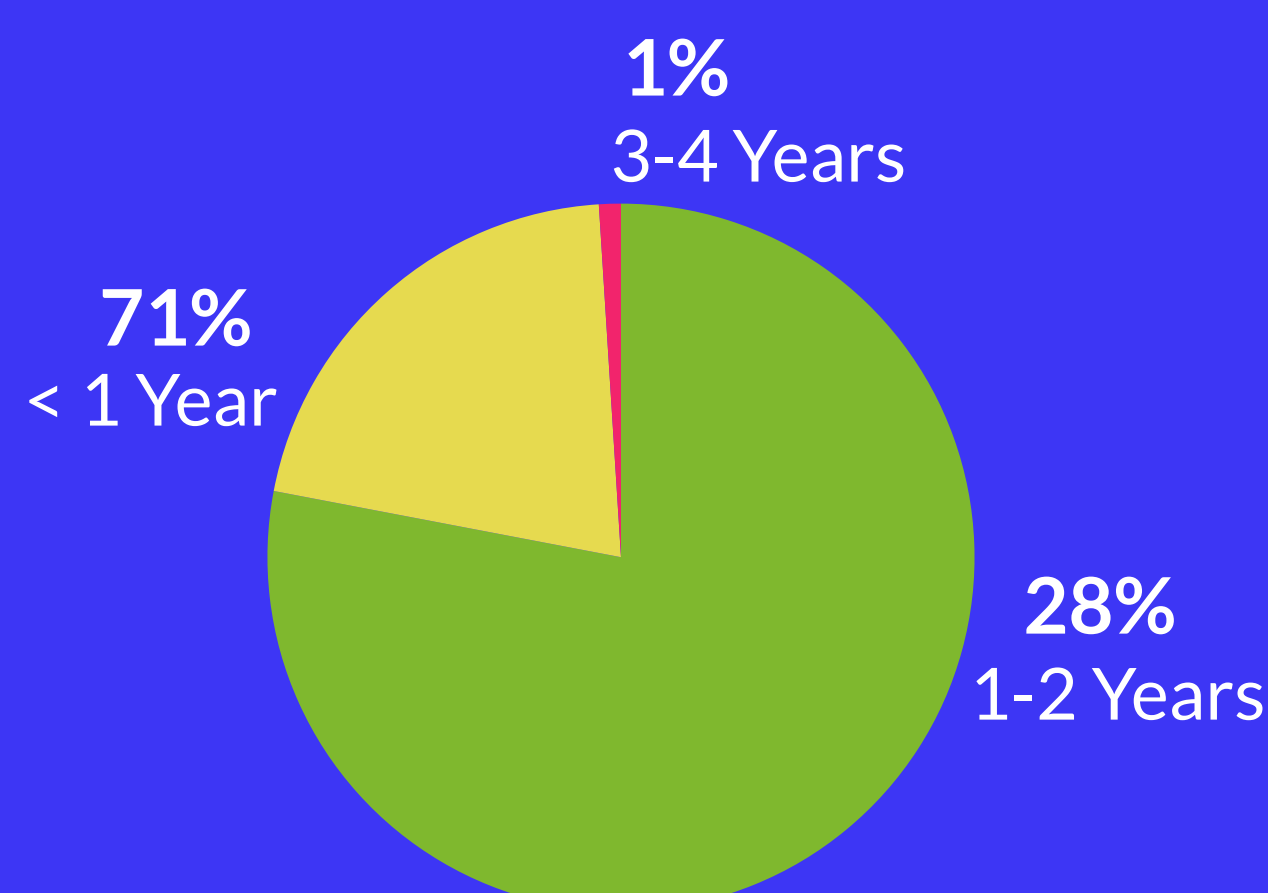
Participant Race



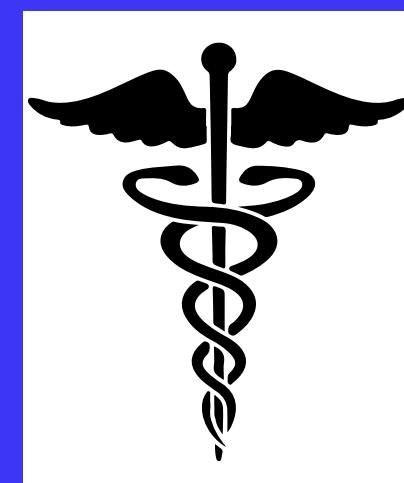
Primary Language



Age of Children

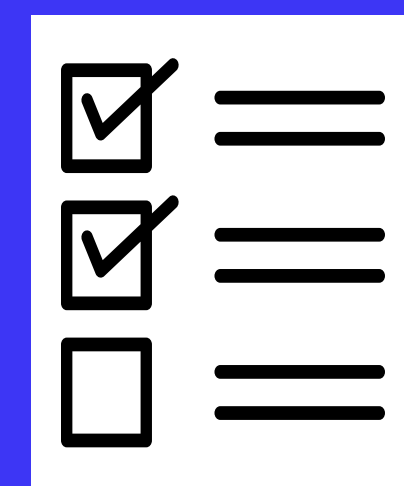

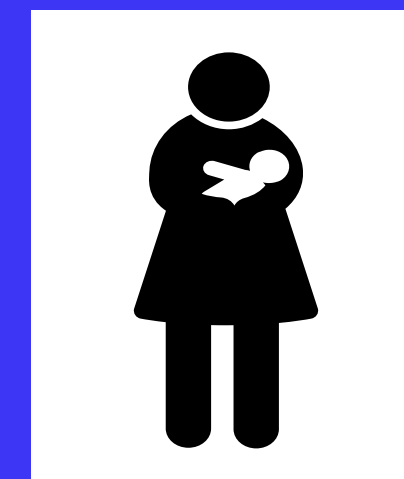

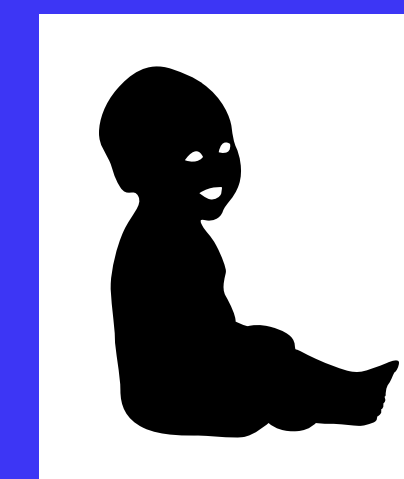

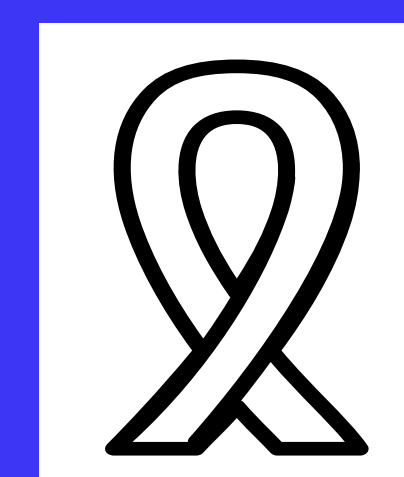
